



WEEKDAY SCHOOL GROUP

9:30 a.m. Arrive at McDonald's Greenhouse Corn Maze

Welcome by Old McDonald. He will explain the layout of the farm and the activities that follow

9:45 a.m. Split into groups of 10-15

(The haywagon can fit about 10-15 people depending on the size of the children or if children sit on parent's laps)
Start a rotation of several activities. Each activity takes about 15-20 minutes.

GAGA BALL PIT	Have a healthy, heart-pumping game of dodge ball in the Gaga Ball Pit.
PEDAL TRACTOR	Enjoy a ride around the track on a pedal tractor – on the tractor color of your choice!
HAY WAGON RIDE	Driver will talk about crops and beef cattle and answer any questions about the farm.
CORN MAZE	Enter and defeat the five acre Corn Maze.
YARD GAMES	Free play on the giant slides & rope spider web.
PETTING ZOO	Pet baby bunnies, chicks, pigs, sheep, goats, and other animals.
EDUCATIONAL	Such activities, based on your group's age, as tasting apple cider, milking Maggie the fiberglass Holstein, reading an autumn-themed book and looking at agricultural displays.
PICK YOUR OWN PUMPKIN	Go out into the field and select your own pumpkin. Hope you can carry it back to the bus!
ENCHANTED FOREST	Take a stroll down to the Enchanted Forest to identify trees, explore the Indian tee-pee, and listen to the quiet.

11:15 a.m. Eat lunch under our picnic shelter, the big barn, or in the sunshine, weather permitting

12:00 p.m. Go back through the maze or play in the sand box under the shade or hold the baby chicks one more time.

12:15 p.m. Head to the bus!

There is a handicapped portalet and lots of hand sanitizer available.

Depending on the age of the children and the wishes of the teachers, Old McDonald can talk about farm living & honey bees, let you feel wool from a sheep or explain how he cuts the maze and grows the pumpkins.

Each child gets a "school house" pumpkin to take home as part of the school group fee! It's about the size of a volleyball.
